To complete the scholarship application for the Pipe Fitters Local Union 533 Scholarship, follow these steps:

1. Verify eligibility: Ensure you have a legal guardian who is a member in good standing with the Pipe Fitters Local Union 533.
2. Gather documents: Prepare a copy of your local high school transcripts and any other relevant information that may be needed to complete the application.
3. Fill out the application form: Provide personal information, academic information, and answers to any questions asked on the form.
4. Fill out the application form: Provide all personal and academic information requested, and answers to any questions asked on the form. Please complete application using your own, human-generated input- no AI assistance is allowed.
5. Meet scholarship requirements: If you are selected as a scholarship winner, ensure you are enrolled in a full-time program at an accredited college or career school and maintain a 2.5 minimum GPA per semester.

Note: If your GPA drops below 2.5, you will lose any remaining scholarship allocations. What is left will be awarded to an alternate from your award year. This is a four (4) year \$10,000 undergraduate scholarship in the amount of \$1,250 per Fall/Spring semester.
